Resolution:

1. Proceedings of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.
2. Sk. Akbar Hossain presented the pre-registration seminar lecture on his Ph.D. proposal entitled 'Islam Allah O Advaita Vedanter Brahman' before the members of the Ph.D. Committee. The members of the Committee were satisfied and suggested some changes in his proposal. So it was unanimously resolved that his Ph.D. proposal, with the incorporation of the suggested changes, be approved and recommended for registration.
3.
