Resolutions of the Departmental Committee meeting (Ref. No.: VU/PG/Chem/157 dated 17.11.2015)

Agenda 1: The applications of Dr. Prasenjit Saha for the position of DST inspire Faculty Fellow in the Dept. of Chemistry and Chemical Technology was thoroughly discussed in the DC meeting. As his specialisation and expertise does not fit in our academic curriculum/syllabus the DC unanimously resolved that he will not be suitable for such a position in the department.

Agenda 2:The note of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor on the application of Prof. J. K. Ray was thoroughly discussed on the DC meeting dated 17.11.2015. It is unanimously resolved that the department will be happy to have him as a 'Visiting Professor' at the department. The matter was verbally discussed with Prof. J. K. Ray and he has given his verbal consent to accept the same.
