- 5. Regular Class Routine has been redrafted and Smart Classes to be used in Tuesday and Friday and same should be reflected in Class routine. Moreover tutorial classes are to reflected in Class routine against each teacher
- 5. In Misc. HOD reported the status of Capitaline Database Package. DC resolved that since there is no fund at present, so both Commerce and Business administration dept. will apply to the honourable Vice Chancellor sir for special permission.

In Misc. HOD also discussed *students' evaluation report of the teachers* and it is found that all teachers' have secured very good scoring (more than 3) during 2018-19 of M.Com. 1st sem. and 3rd sem. students.

However the *following actions are taken* after studying the feedback result of different faculties.

- Academic syllabus of M.Com. and M.Phil. Courses are regularly updating and faculties try to disseminate up-to-date knowledge to the students.
- Teachers are taking tutorial classes regularly from 5 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. for the weak students.
- Teachers are using more virtual class room to develop up-to-date knowledge of the students.
- Teachers are providing suggested readings to the students in advance, not only for M.Com. courses, but also for further studies in different professional courses like ICAI,ICS,ICMA,MBA etc.

Kumari, Mrs. Puja Sharma, Mr. Sujit Mondal, Ms. Suchismita Ghosh, Mr. Tarun Kumar Ray have presented their pre-registration seminar in the department of Commerce in front of the Ph.D. Committee in Commerce. Recommendations and suggestions if any have been noted in their respective forms of pre-registration seminar. All the candidates have been allowed to register their names with minor changes in their proposal. Suggestions are mentioned in the next page of this resolution.
- In Misc. the Secretary of the Ph. D. Committee has placed the application of Mr. Ram 3. Ranjan Routh regarding extension of time period for research work of one year and the Ph.D. committee in Commerce has approved it.
