At the outset of the meeting HoD, Prof. Dilip Kumar Maiti, welcomes all the members and the following matters were discussed as per the notice:


1. The Committee confirmed the proceedings of last DC meeting held on 13.06.2019 & uploaded in the website.

5. All teachers showed their agitation whether the course in evening mode would be a effective one. It has also discussed, that seat of some colleges remains vacant in these days as many colleges offer this course in regular mode .However if university feels that this course would be a popular one then all the members are ready for it. It would be better if you could take care of the following conditions :
 - a) Considering the result 2017-18, 2018-19 of the University, number bar for admission in M.Sc course should be 55% marks in this mode. Undernoted reasons may follow:
 - i) Upto the academic year of 2017, Students admitted on the basis of eligibility criteria and all the seats filled up where the averages score of the last candidate would 65%. It was observed that 100% of the students werepassed with good numbers in those consequent years.
 - ii) After dissolving the number bar, the incapability of students is quite visible as 13 students failed in 2018 and 7 students failed in 2019.
 - b) Age bar should be maintained as per regular mode since the age gap between the current admission year and next academic year is not appropriate to complete the course like mathematics.
