Professor there should be a clarity on the nature of the sample, whether Department of Sociology is homogeneous or heterogeneous?

2. Check on the sequence of the Research questions and objectives. More clarity suggested.
3. Researcher should give more emphasis on method of data collection. Since mixed method is applied then is the support of statistical part.
4. No theoretical framework has been mentioned by the scholar.
5. Number of objectives of the research is more/objectives should be short list.
6. Socio-demographic characteristics of the sample should be mentioned.
7. Perception of corruption should be related to socio-economic demographic profiles/Parameters.

8. Theoretical link between crime and corruption should be highlighted.

Professor Tapan Kumar De :

9. Ask the candidate to clarify the perception of corruption and her main focus of the study.

Dr. Jami Saha, the scholar answered all the questions asked by the members of the Ph.D. Committee and she agreed to incorporate (wherever possible) the suggestions in her final Ph.D. thesis.
