The following resolutions were adopted in the meeting:

Agenda-1: Discussion on the letters received from the Office of the Registrar (Letter No: LA/VU/Trans./2019-23/AQ-30 and LA/VU/Trans./2019-23/AQ-32, Dated 20/07/2023) to the DC meeting dated 24.07.23) relating to the affiliation of colleges/ institutions, requirement of AICTE approval of the institutions and other irregularities, grant of admission by collecting additional fees by the University etc.

Resolution-1: The Head, Department of Business Administration have placed two letters received from the Office of the Registrar (Letter No: LA/VU/Trans./2019-23/AQ-30 and LA/VU/Trans./2019-23/AQ-32, Dated 20/07/2023) to the DC meeting dated 24.07.23.

After through observations of the above stated letters, it is unanimously opined that the Department of Business Administration is nowhere involved in the process of affiliation of MBA course to any Institute. The Department only runs the regular on campus MBA programme under the approval of AICTE. The University authority looks after the functioning of the Institutes where BBA and MBA programmes are running. However, the Department suggested to the Inspector of Colleges in its letter dated 2nd February, 2022 to seek the necessary approval of AICTE from the affiliated Institutes to run their courses.

With reference to the letter (LA/VU/Trans./2019-23/AQ-32, Dated 20/07/2023) regarding the grant of admission of EIILM and BIBS having less than 45% marks in Graduation, the decision has been taken by the University authority. The Department is also nowhere involved into the above matter. However, the VU Committee in its meeting dated 11.05.22 clearly stated that the students (General Category) having less than 45% marks in Graduation should not be considered for taking admission into the MBA programme.

The Head, Department of Business Administration is entrusted to communicate the decisions to the office of the Registrar of the University.
