1. Maximum Score: 100
2. Interview/Viva: 30
3. The remaining 70 score be put into on the basis of following test qualified:
 - a. NET (JRF) : 70
 - b. NET (Asst. Prof.)/SET: 60
 - c. NET (Eligible for research) /ME/M.Tech.: 50
 - d. RET (VU: 2023-24 only): 40
4. Minimum marks for eligibility :50
5. Merit list is to be prepared category wise.
