6. Discussion on organising a Seminar/Conference/Workshop and MoU with other Institutions.
7. Miscellaneous matters, if any.

Departmental Committee Meeting (Meeting No. 60. Dated: 29.10.2025)

Members present:

The members of the DC have reached a unanimous decision concerning the matters outlined in the agenda:

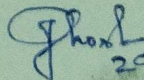
1. The decisions made during the last DC meeting (Meeting No. 59 held on 13th August 2025) were reviewed and approved in the current meeting.
2. The Departmental Committee deliberated on the estimated budget for the financial year 2026-2027 and the revised estimates for 2025-2026. Following the discussion, the Committee prepared the departmental recurring budget as outlined below:

Furthermore, the Committee requested the Head of the Department to forward the approved budget and revised estimates to the Finance Officer for necessary action and further processing.

3. Professor Tapan Kumar De, Chief Editor of the departmental journal *Philosophy and the Life-World*, informed the committee about the progress of Volume 28. He reported that a substantial number of papers have been received and requested the editorial board members' assistance in expediting the review and finalisation process to ensure timely publication.
4. The Committee convened to deliberate on the selection of optional papers for the 1st Semester of 2025. Following comprehensive discussions, we have decided on the subjects to be offered: PHI-(DSC-1) – Philosophy of Mind (Optional Paper) and Philosophical Issues in Mental Illness (Optional Paper). Students are required to select one optional subject of their choice. Furthermore, the Committee has determined that the allocation of these papers among faculty members will be conducted based on areas of specialisation and a balanced distribution of workload. This approach is intended to foster an effective teaching environment that benefits both faculty and students.
5. Regarding the allocation of Mentors for the Students of 1st and 3rd Semesters 2025, the Departmental Committee unanimously decided to settle it after the issue of enrollment numbers.
6. The Departmental Committee discussed the proposal to organise a Seminar, Conference and Workshop during the financial year 2025-26. It was resolved that a Seminar on "The Philosophy of Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar" be organised, and Professor Tapan Kumar De and Professor Jhadeswar Ghosh be entrusted with the responsibility of taking necessary initiatives for its successful organisation. Additionally, the Committee agreed to organize a Workshop, following the pattern of the previous year, under the joint coordination of Professor Jhadeswar Ghosh and Dr. Sreejith K. K. Regarding the Conference, Professor Jhadeswar Ghosh expressed his willingness to organize and apply for financial assistance from the Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR) to host a Three-Day International Conference on "The Inner Voice of Silence: A Philosophical Inquiry into Ultimate Reality in Wittgenstein and the Upanishadic Tradition." The Departmental Committee unanimously approved the proposal and authorised Professor Ghosh to undertake the necessary steps and correspondence with the concerned authorities for its implementation. The Committee also deliberated on the possibility of entering into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with reputed academic and research institutions for promoting mutual cooperation in teaching, research, and extension activities. It was further resolved that the Head of the Department shall take necessary steps to initiate the planning of the proposed academic event(s) and to explore potential institutional partners for the MoU, in consultation with the concerned authorities.
7. In the miscellaneous items, the committee convened to discuss the application for an experience certificate from Mohasina Khatun, Senior Research Fellow (UGC), and unanimously decided to issue the certificate in recognition of her voluntary and honorary contributions to teaching M.A. classes. The committee believes that this certificate will support her future endeavours and requests that the necessary steps be taken to issue it promptly.

As there were no additional issues to discuss, the meeting came to a close, leaving participants with heartfelt best wishes for their future endeavours and accomplishments.
