The Departmental Committee unanimously resolved the following agenda items:

1. The decisions made during the last DC meeting (Meeting No. 61 held on 11th November 2025) were reviewed and approved in the current meeting.
2. The Departmental Committee convened to review the statement of expenditure as per the approved budget and to acknowledge the successful conclusion of the two-day Workshop on Mental Health, Self-Awareness, and Philosophical Counselling, which took place on December 3rd and 4th, 2025. The committee recognized the significance of this workshop in promoting awareness and dialogue surrounding these essential subjects within our community.
3. The Departmental Committee unanimously resolved to organize an International Seminar titled "The Philosophy of Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar." The seminar is proposed to be held in the second week of March 2026.

6. During the Miscellaneous agenda, the Departmental Committee made significant progress by addressing three additional items on the agenda.

- (i) The Committee is excited to embark on the organisation of a special lecture titled "Philosophy of Kant: An Introduction." This initiative aims to enhance our understanding of philosophical concepts. We are grateful to Professor Sunil Roy, former Professor of Philosophy at Burdwan University, for agreeing to share his insights and expertise as our speaker at this event.
