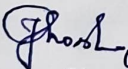

Departmental Committee Meeting (Meeting No. 64, Dated: 07.04.2026)

Members present:

The members of the DC have reached a unanimous resolution concerning the matters outlined in the agenda:

1. The resolutions made during the last DC meeting (Meeting No. 63 held on 7th January 2026) were reviewed and approved in the current meeting.
2. The Departmental Committee deliberated upon the application for financial assistance from the Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR) for the celebration of Indian Philosopher's Day and the International Day of Yoga. The Committee unanimously resolved that Professor Tapan Kumar De shall submit the application for Indian Philosophers' Day, and Dr. Sreejith K. K. shall submit the application for the International Day of Yoga.
3. The utilization statement submitted by Professor Jhadeswar Ghosh, Joint Convener of the International Seminar held on 10th and 11th March 2026, was placed before the members of the Committee for consideration. After detailed discussion and careful examination of the statement of expenditure and related documents, the Committee expressed its satisfaction regarding the proper

utilization of the funds and unanimously approved the same. Thereafter, the members deliberated on the academic outcomes and significance of the International Seminar and unanimously resolved that an edited volume comprising selected research papers presented during the Seminar should be published as the official proceedings of the Seminar. The proposed volume shall include scholarly contributions in both English and Bengali to ensure wider academic participation and the dissemination of knowledge. The Committee further entrusted Professor Jhadeswar Ghosh with the responsibility of communicating with the participants, collecting and compiling the full papers, coordinating the editorial process, and taking the necessary steps to publish the edited volume in accordance with academic standards and publication norms.

4. The Committee was informed that the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Vidyasagar University, had provided a revised and rectified model framework for the correction and restructuring of the Postgraduate NEP syllabus for the academic session 2025–2026, which had earlier been prepared by the PG Board of Studies. After careful consideration of the IQAC's guidelines and recommendations, the Departmental Committee thoroughly reviewed the existing syllabus and prepared a rectified version in conformity with the prescribed model and academic requirements. The Committee unanimously approved the revised syllabus and resolved that the same be submitted to the Office of the PG Secretary for necessary action and further approval by the competent authority.
5. Under the miscellaneous agenda, Professor Tapan Kumar De, Chief Editor of the *Departmental journal Philosophy and the Life-world*, placed before the Committee a proposal for the allocation of a tentative amount of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) towards composition and typesetting expenses for the forthcoming volume of the journal for the session 2025–2026. The members discussed the proposal in detail and acknowledged the academic importance and regular publication of the departmental journal as a significant platform for scholarly research and intellectual exchange. Considering the necessity of professional composition work to maintain publication quality and standards, the Committee unanimously approved the proposed expenditure. The Committee further resolved to authorise Professor Tapan Kumar De to undertake the necessary arrangements for the composition work and to submit the relevant expenditure bill and supporting documents to the University authority for reimbursement after the completion of the work and the submission of the final composed materials by the concerned expert.

There being no other matters to discuss, the meeting concluded with thanks to all members and best wishes for their future endeavours.
