- (c) (i) Discuss how Jameson attempts to characterize the nature of cultural production in the second half of the 20th century and to distinguish it from other forms of cultural production of preceding capitalist eras.

- (ii) How does Badiou's notion of the event approximate the Lacanian Real?
- 2. Comment on any three of the following: 3x4
 - (a) (i) Tetralinguistic model of Henri Gobard.

Or

- (ii) "It is hyperreal. It is a universe of simulation, which is something altogether different".
- (b) (i) Lyotard's differentiation between scientific discourse and mythical discourse.

Or

- (ii) "The cyborg would not recognize the Garden of Eden; it is not made of mud and cannot dream of returning to dust."
- (c) (i) Postmodern mode of production as a "cultural dominant".
