(i) If α , β , γ are the roots of the equation $x^3 + px^2 + qx + r = 0$, find the equation whose roots are $-\frac{1}{\alpha}$, $-\frac{1}{6}$, $-\frac{1}{x}$.

- (ii) Find the inverse of the matrix $A = \begin{bmatrix} 5 & 3 \\ -2 & 2 \end{bmatrix}$.
- (iii) Prove that for any two events A and B, $P(A + B) \le P(A) + P(B)$.
- (iv) Evaluate: $\int_{0}^{\frac{\pi}{2}} \sin^{2} x \, dx$
- (v) Solve the equation $x^3 3x^2 + 4 = 0$ where two roots are equal.
- (vi) Show that for two independent variates, correlation coefficient is zero.
- (vii) If X is a discrete random variable having the following probability mass functions:

x : 0 1 2 3 4 5 6

P(X = x) : 0 K 2K 3K 4K 5K 6K

Determine the constant K.

(viii) The mean and variance of the Binomial (n,p) distribution are respectively 20 and 16. Find the value of n and p.

(ix) Two coins are tossed at a time. Write down the sample space. Find the probality of getting one head and one tail.

(x) Prove that
$$\int_{a}^{b} f(x) dx = \int_{a}^{b} f(a + b - x) dx.$$

- 2. (a) State Descarte's rule of signs regarding the existence of roots of polynomial equation with real coefficients. Show that the equation $x^4 + 16x^2 + 7x 10 = 0$ has one positive, one negative and two imaginary roots. 5
 - (b) If one of the roots of the equation $x^3 + px^2 + qx + r = 0$, equals the sum of the other two, then prove that $p^3 + 8r = 4pq$.
- 3. (a) Verify Cayby Hamilton theorem for the matrix:

$$A = \begin{pmatrix} 1 & 1 & 3 \\ 5 & 2 & 6 \\ -2 & -1 & -3 \end{pmatrix}. \text{ Hence find A}^{-1}.$$

(b) Solve the equation: $27x^3 + 42x^2 - 28x - 8 = 0$ whose roots are in G.P.

4. (a) Solve by Cardan's method : $x^3 - 24x + 72 = 0$

(b) If α , β , ν be the roots of $x^3 - 3x^2 + 8x - 5 = 0$, find the equation whose roots are $2\alpha + 3$, $2\beta + 3$, $2\nu + 3$.

- (a) State Rolle's theorem and Lagrange's Mean Value theorem.
 - (b) If $y = (\sin^{-1} x)^2$, prove that $(1-x^2) y_{n+2} - (2n+1)xy_{n+1} - n^2y_n = 0.$ 5
- **6.** (a) If $u(x, y) = f(x^2 + 2yz, y^2 + 2zx)$, prove that

$$(y^2-zx) \frac{\partial u}{\partial x} + (x^2-yz) \frac{\partial u}{\partial y} + (z^2-xy) \frac{\partial u}{\partial z} = 0.$$

- (b) If $u = \frac{x^2 + y^2}{\sqrt{x + y}}$, $(x,y) \neq (0,0)$, what should be the value
 - of K so that $x \frac{\partial u}{\partial x} + y \frac{\partial u}{\partial y} = Ku$.?
- (c) If $u = x^y$, show that $\frac{\partial^2 u}{\partial x \partial y} = \frac{\partial^2 u}{\partial y \partial x}$.

$$\lim_{n \to \infty} \left[\frac{n}{n^2} + \frac{n}{1^2 + n^2} + \frac{n}{2^2 + n^2} + \dots + \frac{n}{(n-1)^2 + n^2} \right]$$

(b) Evaluate: $\int \frac{\mathrm{dx}}{(1-x)\sqrt{1-x^2}}$

- 8. (a) State classical definition of probability. Deduce that:
 - (i) $0 \le P(A) \le 1$;
 - (ii) P(S) = 1, where A is any arbitrary event in the event space S.
 - (b) In an examination 30% of the students failed in Mathematics, 15% of the students failed in Chemistry and 10% of the students failed in both Chemistry and Mathematics. A student is selected at random. If he failed in Chemistry, then what is probability that the student passed in Mathematics?
