- 2. Attempt any one of the following questions: 15×1
 - (a) Why was the original title of the novel *Pride* and *Prejudice* discarded? Do you think that the new title reflects the theme of the novel? Substantiate your view.
 - (b) Do you think that Frankenstein is "a commentary on the limitations of science and reason" - Discuss.
 - (c) Asses the role of Jeanie Deans in The Heart of Midlothian.
- 3. Attempt any one of the following questions: 10×1
 - (a) Discuss the autobiographical elements in 'Dream Children'.
 - (b) In Hazlitt 'every sentence is a confession' Do you agree? Substantiate your view drawing examples from 'On a Sun-dial'.

- 4. Attempt any two of the following questions: $15 \times$
 - (a) "To the Skylark' and 'To a Skylark' bring out contrasted views on life" Discuss.
 - (b) Comment on the significance of the title of "Dejection-an Ode".
 - (c) Locate the elements of Romantic poetry in "Ode to a Nightingale".
 - (d) In what ways is 'The Raven' a representative poem of Poe?
 - 5. Attempt any *one* of the following questions: $10 \times$
 - (a) Discuss "Ode to the West Wind" as an Ode.
 - (b) Discuss the 'Chimney-Sweeper' poems as Blake's tirades against the Pseudo-philanthropic assumptions in contemporary England.
- 6. Attempt any three of the following questions: $5 \times$
 - (a) Comment upon Jane Austen's attitude towards marriage in *Pride and Prejudice*.

- (b) Comment upon the 'Christian elements' in Mary Shelley's Frankenstein.
- (c) Comment upon Scott's attitude towards 'Presbyterianism' in *The Heart of Midlothian*.
- (d) What constitutes the 'Poetic faith' in Wordsworth's *Tintern Abbey*?
- (e) Comment on the ending of Keats's 'Ode on a Grecian Urn'.
- (f) What does Shelley say about the 'art' in the Skylark's song?
