

Resolution of the Ph.D. Meeting in Commerce held on 30.11.2017 :

Due to absence of Hon'ble Vice-chancellor and Chairman, Ph.D. Committee, Prof. D.Mishra, Dean, Arts and Commerce was requested to chair the meeting which he obliged.

1. The Resolution of the meeting dated 10th August, 2017 has been confirmed.
2. The pre-submission seminar was presented by Mr. Saswata Chowdhury on the basis of his presentation and consequent discussion the following suggestions were offered :
 - a) The justification of considering lag is to be stated clearly.
 - b) In case of analysis and interpretation all the impacted i.e. positive impact and negative impact is to be demonstrated in the study.
 - c) The justification of non-inclusion of variables is to be stated explicitly.On incorporation of the above suggestions and the consequent issue area of certificate of supervisor, Mr. Saswata Chowdhury, may submit the thesis as per the rule of the university.
3. Mr. Ram Ranjan Routh was asked to present his seminar due to change in topic of Ph.D. thesis however, the committee, on the basis of write up of the seminar, asked questions about the similarity of topic variable considered and methodology applied. It was resolved that, Mr. Ram Ranjan Routh would be suggested to modify the title of the prepared and area of coverage of the study and may present his seminar in subsequent meeting of Ph.D. Committee.
4. On the basis of application of Mr. Durga Prasad Bera, the title of Ph.D. dissertation was allowed to change from "Performance Appraisal of Charitable Organisations : A Case Study of some Charitable Organisations in Purba and Paschim Medinipur Dsistrict of West Bengal" to "Performance Appraisal of Non-Government Organisations : A Case Study of Selected Organisations in Purba and Paschim Medinipur District of West Bengal".
5. On the basis of application of Mr. Dipak Kundu, the title of the Ph.D. dissertation was allowed to change from "A Study on Lending Trends of Commercial Banks in India with special reference to Priority Sector" to "A Study on Lending Trends of Scheduled Commercial Banks in India with Special Reference to Priority Sector".
6. On the basis of application of Mr. Dipak Kundu seeking extension of registration time period by one year, it has been decided to allow another one year from the date of ceasation of registration i.e. 8th November, 2018. This allowance was granted as per Ph.D. regulation vide Clause 6(iii).
7. The list of examiner for evaluation of Ph.D. thesis of Sri Saswata Chowdhury has been prepared.

No other discussion took place in the meeting.
