To discuss the matter regarding the lien of Dr. B. Sarkar as per direction of the registrar with Letter Ref. No (Ref. VU/R/WC-04/C337/2016 dated 21.07.2016)

Resolution: DC members have resolved the following:

- 1. One Post having Associate Professor (Exempted Category) is vacant since 2010.
- 2. Another post of Assistant Professor is for Dr. Biswajit Sarkar. In this case, it is noticed that initially for more than one year, he was on leave for PDF after serving the Department for less than 3 years from the date of joining to the university. After return back he served the department around 1 year. Again he is enjoining leave with lien for two years from 01.09.2014 till now. So out of his 6 years 5 months service in this department from the date of joining to 31st August 2016, he is on leave including lien period for more than 3 years.
- 3. At present total number of faculties and students are 6 and 170 respectively in regular mode of PG courses.
- 4. During the lien period, Dr. Sarkar has published some research papers where he has not mentioned the name of his parent university.

Under the above situations, the Department is facing lot of difficulties such as, allocating the PG classes for regular students, assigning project supervisor/guide to the 4th Semester PG students for their project work and other academic activities. As a consequence, students are being deprived from his service in the Department for long days.

Therefore, looking to the benefit of students, Department unanimously has agreed not to extend the leave with lien further.
