


The meeting was chaired by Amiya Kumar Panda, Head, Department of Chemistry and Chemical Technology, Vidyasagar University.


Resolutions:


1. Proceedings of the last DC meeting held on July 31, 2018 was read and confirmed.
2. With references to the email received from the Deputy Inspector of Colleges, Vidyasagar University, the Departmental Committee discussed the matter to open PG evening courses in Chemistry. Prof. Prakash Chandra Dhara, Director, Centre for Continuing Adult Education, Mr. Chinmoy Banerjee, Deputy Director, DDE and Dr. Soma Das, Core Faculty, DDE were invited. Prof. Prakash Chandra Dhara, Director, Centre for Continuing Adult Education made an introduction remark on the need of an evening course in M.Sc. (Chemistry). Some faculty members opined that there might be some constraints in conducting the classes on regular basis in view of the ongoing teaching and research loads of the faculty members. It was proposed that there might be no compulsion for the teachers in taking the classes. However, in view of the needs, as also opined by the University authority, it was resolved that the P.G evening course in Chemistry might be introduced as self-financing course. It was also proposed that Dr. Soma Das, Core Faculty in Chemistry, may act as the Course Coordinator. It was also been proposed that the existing syllabus of the PG courses in Chemistry (Regular mode) would be implemented. Further discussion in this regard may be made.
3. With references to a letter from the Principal, Behala College, the Departmental Committee recommends that Dr. Ujjal Kumar Sur of Behala College may be allowed to pursue collaborating research with Prof. Amiya Kumar Panda for the time being subject to the approval of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.
4. Miscellaneous:
 - i) Room No. CEM-008 may be used as sitting room for Dr. Anirban Basu with Room No. CEM-002 as the research laboratory.


