Resolutions:-

Agenda 1:- The proceedings of the previous DC meeting held on 26.02.2019 were read and confirmed.

Agenda 2:- Feedback responses of the students (session 2017-18) regarding evaluation of the teachers were placed in the meeting by each and every teacher of the Department. The responses were discussed in the meeting. After thorough discussion on the matter, it was identified that in certain areas such as presentation of ideas and concepts, providing advanced materials or references, providing updated information to the students etc. there are further scopes for improvement, as the DC recommends.

It was unanimously resolved that the concerned teachers of the Department may try to implement the recommendations of the DC on the basis of the ~~extra~~ feedback responses by the students.

Agenda 3:- The HoD placed ~~the~~ before the DC members the letter from the Principal, Khajuri College bearing Ref. No. KC/VU/HoD. Anthro/01/19 dated 13.03.19 through which the Principal has requested the HoD, Anthropology, VU that the college may be provided with some prehistoric tools to conduct the practical classes of the students studying Anthropology in that college.

The matter was thoroughly discussed in the meeting and the DC puts its opinion on record that there is a separate theoretical as well as a separate practical course in the PG syllabus in Anthropology but there is also a paucity of prehistoric tools in the department.

The DC members unanimously resolved that the college students under the supervision of respective teacher(s) may be allowed to conduct specially arranged classes in the departmental laboratory and may use the prehistoric tools of the department.

Agenda 4:- The HoD informed the DC members that a seminar may be organized by the Department in view of the suggestion given by the Honourable Vice-Chancellor, VU during his visit to the Department.

The DC members, after due deliberations on the matter, unanimously resolved that Special Lectures cum State-level Seminar may be organized by the Department. The date for the event was proposed to be 8th May 2019. The theme for the Special Lectures cum State-level Seminar was proposed as "Tribe, Religion, and Folklore: Biocultural Tradition of Anthropology and Beyond".

It was also resolved that experts in these field and belonging to the state of West Bengal will be invited to the event to deliver the Special Lectures. Following names were unanimously suggested by the DC members.

- (ii) Professor Soumen Sen, Former Professor, Department of Literary and Cultural Studies, North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong.


