



- Teachers are using more virtual class room to develop up-to-date knowledge of the students.
- Teachers are providing suggested readings to the students in advance, not only for M.Com. courses, but also for further studies in different professional courses like ICAI, ICS, ICMA, MBA etc.

Resolution of the Ph.D. Meeting in Commerce held on 05.4.2019

1. The proceedings of the earlier meeting held on 01.3.2019 has been read and confirmed.
2. The seven candidates namely Mr. Debashis Biswas, Mrs. Rookshar Akbar, Ms. Binita Kumari, Mrs. Puja Sharma, Mr. Sujit Mondal, Ms. Suchismita Ghosh, Mr. Tarun Kumar Ray have presented their pre-registration seminar in the department of Commerce in front of the Ph.D. Committee in Commerce. Recommendations and suggestions if any have been noted in their respective forms of pre-registration seminar. All the candidates have been allowed to register their names with minor changes in their proposal. Suggestions are mentioned in the next page of this resolution.
3. In Misc. the Secretary of the Ph. D. Committee has placed the application of Mr. Ram Ranjan Routh regarding extension of time period for research work of one year and the Ph.D. committee in Commerce has approved it.
A list of eight external experts for Research Advisory Committee (RAC) in commerce for evaluation of the progress of scholars is recommended by the Ph.D. Committee in Commerce. The list of experts in RAC in Commerce is given separately in an annexure as follows.
In Misc. Prof Kalpataru Bandopadhyay has placed adjudicators list of his scholar Mr. Koustav Roy and the Ph.D. committee recommended it to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor sir.

Outcomes of the Pre-registration Seminar

Mr. Debashis Biswas:

1. Title Should be change as "An Assessment of Performance of some selected Mutual Fund Schemes in India"
2. In literature review Journal name as well as article name need not be mentioned.
3. Time period (2008-2018) is short, so if extension is possible consider it.
4. Benchmark strategy utility in portfolio management should be highlighted.
5. Highlight on contradiction of daily return and portfolio return measurement

Mrs. Rookshar Akbar:

1. In objectives of the study one of the objective will be how much fly ash emitted and simultaneously it is recycled.
2. In fly ash management put emphasis on human health impact and impact cost could be measured in terms of present value of future medical cost by discounting.
3. For primary data collections through questionnaire prepare a pilot survey.
4. Null hypotheses should be corrected.
5. In study period 10 years which are mentioned in synopsis that is for secondary data; but in primary data 3 to 4 years gap survey to be done to measure the impact.

Ms. Binita Kumari :

1. How your work differs from other's work should be highlighted.
2. Reasons of migration from agricultural sector to service sector and village to town etc should be highlighted.

Mrs. Puja Sharma :- No Suggestions

Mr. Sujit Mondal:

1. Study role of Manager in CSR if fitting fixed effect model is fitted in Panel data analysis is selected.
2. Objective 1 and 2 should be re-written because CSR expenditure is at least 2% of average net profit of last 3 years as per companies act, 2013.

Mr. Suchismita Ghosh:

1. Justify your study of impact of financial performance on environmental performances.
2. Chapter plan should be revised because only in chapter 5 your contribution exists; it will be better to include another two chapters of your findings.
3. Content analysis may be done for measurement of environmental pollution.
4. The title of the Ph.D. work is changed to “ Environmental Pollution, Firms’ characteristics and Environmental Sustainability of selected Indian Companies”


Mr. Tarun Kumar Ray:


