 - (d) What is so offensive about the pardoner in Chaucer's Prologue to The Canterbury Tales?
 - (e) Comment on: "My mistress's eyes are nothing like the sun".
 - (f) What does Shakespeare say to his friend in Sonnet no. 87?
 - (g) How does Pope describe Atticus in 'An Epistle to Dr Arbuthnot'?
 - (h) Locate any two elements of Horatian satire in 'An Epistle to Dr. Arbuthnot'.

 - (a) What is the structure of a Shakespearean Sonnet? What is its rhyme scheme?
 - (b) Why doesn't Shakespeare want to compare his friend's beauty with a summer's day in Sonnet No.18?

 - (d) What was the immediate occasion for the publication of Pope's 'An epistle to Dr. Arbuthnot'?
 - (e) "If gold ruste what shall iron do?" Who uses this figure of speech in the Prologue to The Canterbury Tales and why?
 - (f) Whom does Chaucer describe first in the Prologue to The Canterbury Tales and why?
 - (g) Name two earthy professions that Donne refers to in 'The Canonization'.
 - (h) Explain the significance of the word 'die' in the line 'We can die by it, if not live by love'.
