- (e) What is the title of the third chapter of *Tess*? What is its significance?
- (f) Mention the names of the girls who worked with Tess at Talbothays farm.
- (g) What were Wollstonecraft's views on the beauty of women?
- (h) Who was Mary Wollstonecraft's father? Who was her husband?
