#### Resolutions

## Agendum 1

(a) All the data related to the DVV by NAAC sought by the IQAC of the University, related to the following, have been approved by the Department Committee and sent to the IQAC:

- (i) Mentoring Students during 2018-2019 (2.3.3 of the SSR)
- (ii) NET / SET qualifiers: copies of their certificates (5.2.3.2 of the SSR)
- (iii) ATRs on the basis of the Students and Parents feedback.
- (iv) Students' Satisfaction Survey: All the recipients of the link have responded (according to the students), implying 100% response.
- (v) Change in the Syllabus: Major change from the syllabus of 2013-2014 to that of 2018-2019 [via the 2016-2017 syllabus] (1.1.2 of the SSR)
- (vi) Various Counselling / Coaching Activities (5.1.3 of the SSR)

### Agendum 2

- (a) The process of printing this year's *Journal of the Department of English*, Vidyasagar University has been initiated.
- (b) The soft copy version shall be sent to the Information Scientist of the University for uploading in the Vidyasagar University website.
- (c) The University should be requested to develop a mechanism of purchase of the Journal by interested subscribers, which will facilitate earning of revenue for the University.

## Agendum 3

- (a) Mr. Hemant Kumar Golapalli and Mr. Shubhendu Shekhar Naskar shall coordinate the logistic support of the online seminar-cum-workshop on Documentation of Dalit and Tribal Cultural Texts, during 7-8 February 2021, as resolved by the Board of Studies in its online meeting held on 21.02.2021, in order to facilitate the process of evaluation for Course No. ENG-105 (Day and Evening Sessions) of the forthcoming Odd Semester Examinations, 2020. The arrangement of contacting the resource persons from ten communities of North and Western Bengal shall be made by Prof. Indranil Acharya, who will also make the necessary arrangements for contacting the Area-Experts and the Valedictory Speaker.
- (i) Representatives from five North Bengal shall be there on the online platform on one day, and five from Western Bengal on the other. The resource person for each community shall address the students, other community members could be included as performers from each community.
- (ii) Two area experts shall deliver the Keynote addresses to explain to the students the methodology of field work and that of digitization of the collected data.
