
Resolution:

- 3) Aaishi Roy delivered her Ph.D pre-registration seminar successfully on the title of her Ph.D topic: "Protective efficacy of *Paederia foetida* leaves against cypoteron acetate-induced testicular hypofunction in rat." and the committee recommended for Ph.D registration of Aaishi Roy under the Supervision of Dr. Chhanda Mallick as per norms.
- 4) Ananya Barman delivered her Ph.D pre-registration seminar successfully on the title of her Ph.D topic: "Benefits of wheatgrass in connection with multi-organ toxicity in female Wistar rat" and the committee recommended for Ph.D registration of Ananya Barman under the Supervision of Dr. Sandip Chattopadhyay as per norms.


the Ph.D topic as per norms in near future considering the current pandemic situation as majority of them were unable to carry out their pilot study due to this current pandemic condition.

- 14) Requests from Lipi Rani Jana (Provisional Registration no. 1196/Ph.D. Dated: 03/11/2017) and Ranjan Guchhait (Provisional Registration no. 065/Ph.D. Dated: 03/11/2018) for discontinuation of Ph.D programme were placed before the committee. The committee recommended that the Ph.D registration of Lipi Rani Jana and Ranjan Guchhait may be cancelled as per the request of the said candidates.

After careful consideration of their request along with the consideration of current perspective of pandemic situation Ph.D. Committee recommended 6 month extension for Farhin Ara i.e. till 13.06.2021; 3 month extension for Moumita Dash i.e. till 13.03.2021 and one year extension for Riya Sarkar i.e. till 13.12.2021.
- 16) The meeting was ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.




