2. Check on the sequence of the Research question and objectives.
More clarity suggested.
3. Researcher should give more emphasis on method of data collection.
Since mixed method is applied when is the support of statistical part.
4. No theoretical framework has ~~been~~ been mentioned by the scholar.
5. Number of objectives of the research is more / objectives should be ~~short~~ ^{brief} stated.
6. Socio-demographic characteristics of the sample should be mentioned.
7. Perception of corruption should be related to socio-economic demographic profiles / parameters.

8. Theoretical link between crime and corruption should be highlighted.
