Minutes of Departmental Committee meeting, Dept. of Applied Mathematics with Oceanology and Computer Programming held on 21.08.2023:

- 1. The resolution of the DC meeting held on 07.08.2023 is read and confirmed.
- 2. In the meeting, the matter of Elective paper fixation is discussed thoroughly with the present DC members. Three lists prepared by the students for giving their opinion to choose the elective papers have been taken. After the discussion, the 2nd list is unanimously accepted by the present DC members in the meeting. Henceforth, the 3rd one which was accepted and circulated on 17.08.2023 is cancelled. All the members agreed with this decision that the class will run from 22.08.2023 according to the 2nd list. It is also decided that students will be given a period of 7 days up to 29.08.2023 for switching their elective paper, if required.
- 3. Miscellaneous:

It is also decided that following measures should be taken for selection of elective papers of 3rd semester in future:

- i. For selection of elective paper, students should offer 7 working days in such a way that they get sufficient time to choose their elective paper.
- ii. It is decided that the minimum number of students in each elective paper is 5 and maximum will be decided on the number of total students in 3rd semester in that particular year.
- iii. Each student has to choose more than one option. According to their preferences, the department will prepare a list subject to availability. If demand exceeds the limit in a particular elective paper, the selection will be based on their marks of 1st semester, otherwise 2nd preferences will be allotted.
- iv. It is also decided that the limitation of students for choosing Elective paper (maximum/minimum number) mentioned in "the syllabus of 2022-23 in page number 7" is irrelevant. Hence; HOD is requested to take necessary steps to remove this portion from the syllabus.
- v. The list elective paper will be prepared by the department and finalized in an emergency D.C meeting. Thereafter; list of students for elective papers will be published as a notice.

As the members feel that there are no other issues to be addressed on that day, the meeting is concluded by thanking all the members.
