Minutes:

In the meeting, all the editorial board members provided updates on the received and pending review reports of the articles assigned to them. They also reported to the house the numbers of accepted and rejected articles after external review. The matter of issuing certificates to the willing reviewers was also discussed. The issue of assigning DOI to individual journal articles also came up for discussion. The members deliberated on the proposed volume of 10 articles by the college teachers to be published with financial assistance. The chief editor informed the members that Prof. M. Mani Meitei had already sent the invited article to him.

Resolutions: Resolved that the members of the editorial board would send the accepted and revised articles to the chief editor by 15.10.2022 and the chief editor would also circulate the first draft of the editorial along the same timeline.

It was also resolved that the chief editor would request the Vidyasagar University Publication Division (VUPD) or the university authorities to arrange for the purchase of DOI numbers after the submission of the final manuscript.

The editorial board members further resolved that Prof. Ashok K. Mohapatra be requested to send the second invited article by mid-October 2022.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor be requested to write a Foreword for the proposed volume of 10 articles.
