- 3. How does Ācārya Śamkara establish that the intention of Bhagavana Śrī Kṛṣṇa was not to instruct about jñāna-karma-samuccaya? Explain after Śamkara Bhāṣya on the Sāmkhyayoga adhyāya of Śrīmadbhagavadgītā.
- 4. Explain the main tenets of karmayoga following Śrimadbhagavadgītā.

- 8. Discuss the meaning of the terms 'jāyate', 'mriyate', 'sāsvata' and 'purāṇa' composed in the sloka-2/20 after the Gītābhāṣya of Ācārya Śaṃkara.
- 9. State the main argument of jñāna-karma samuccayavāda.

10. Explain the following sloka of Śrimad-bhagavadgitā.
