 - (a) In which year Crisis in Civilisation was published?
 - (b) What is the connotation of the term Satyagraha?

- (c) In which context did Gandhi coin the term Satyagraha?
- (d) What was the most influential work of Ambedkar on caste?
- **2.** Answer *any* **two** questions from the following : $4 \times 2 = 8$
 - (a) Write briefly on the context of Crisis in Civilisation.
 - (b) Briefly compare between Passive Resistance and Satyagraha.
 - (c) Write a short note on Ambedkar's main arguments in Annihilation of Caste.
 - (d) Point out in brief the main differences in the views of Gandhi and Ambedkar on 'caste'.
- **3.** Answer any **one** question from the following: $8 \times 1=8$
 - (a) "Today I live in the hope that the Saviour is coming that he will be born in our midst in the poverty-shamed hovel which is India." (Tagore, *Crisis in Civilisation*) Explicate.
 - (b) "The principle called Satyagraha came into being before that name was invented." (Gandhi, An Autobiography) Discuss, following Gandhi, the events that led to the invention of the word Satyagraha.

- **4.** Answer any **two** questions from the following : 2×2=4
 - (a) Who originated the idea of the Panopticon?
 - (b) In which year the public execution of Damiens took place?
 - (c) In which year did Habermas first deliver the talk on "Modernity - An Incomplete Project"?
 - (d) In which essay did Charles Taylor elaborate his views on 'identity'?
- **5.** Answer *any* **two** questions from the following : $4 \times 2 = 8$
 - (a) How did Foucault describe the two images of discipline in France?
 - (b) Write a short note on the Foucauldian concept of Normalizing Judgement.
 - (c) "... should we try to hold on the intentions of Enlightenment feeble as they may be, or should we declare the entire project of modernity a lost case?" (Habermas) Briefly explain the statement.
 - (d) What significance, according to Taylor, does the modern notion of 'dignity' carry in place of the old notion of 'honour'?

- **6.** Answer *any* **one** question from the following : 8×1=8
 - (a) Discuss, following Foucault, the transition of the penal system in Western society from punishment to discipline.
 - (b) "Non-recognition or misrecognition can inflict harm, can be a form of oppression, imprisoning someone in a false, distorted, and reduced mode of being." (Charles Taylor) Explain after Taylor with suitable examples.
