Resolution:

1. The proceedings of the last meeting that of the Departmental Committee in Chemistry read and confirmed.

2. HoD reported to the members of the committee that if it is possible to invite TCG Lifesciences Pvt. Ltd., Kolkata (a MoU has already been signed between TCG Lifesciences Pvt. Ltd. and Vidyasagar university through the Department of Chemistry) for conducting a campus interview to recruit the final semester (SEM-IV) students and to give them a job opportunity in a Pharmaceutical company. The members of the DC gladly and unanimously accepted the proposal and requested the HoD to take necessary steps for conducting the campus interview.

3. Based on the letter received from the office of the Vice-Chancellor dated 24.04.2023 HoD reported to the members of the DC that a deficient amount of Rs. 20,750/- for conducting the International Symposium "Science Beyond Boundary: Invention, Discovery, Innovation and Society" dated 28.04.2023 may be adjusted from the Special lecture head of the Chemistry Department. In this context the members of the DC unanimously resolved that Rs. 20,750/- may be adjusted from 'Special Lecture Head' of the Department of Chemistry for the International symposium subject to the approval of the appropriate authority after the deposition of the total earnings (through registration of students, scholars and other participants) of the symposium to the University.

i) HoD reported to the members of the DC that a letter was received (Ref. No. VU/VC/SO/69/2023 dated 02.05.2023) from the Special Officer, VU requesting to submit the

names of 12 (twelve) experts out of which 7 (seven) should be within the state and another 5 (five) should be national level from outside the state of West Bengal, having the rank not below the rank of Professor or equivalent academic position. 




The members of the DC recommended the submission of the proposal.
