The Teacher-in-Charge took the chair and thanks to all the members being present for the DC meeting through online. The members present express their greetings to each other. The Resolutions of the last DC meeting held on 31.01.2022 were read out and confirmed. Dr. Suratha Kumar Malik, Teacher-in-Charge of the department has discussed regarding the course workload distribution among the teachers for the upcoming 2nd and 4th Semester, 2022 and also the development regarding Department Journal. He also proposed to accommodate Dr. Santi Sarkar as guest faculty owing to the dearth of faculties in the department. After thorough discussion, the DC unanimously resolved the following:

1) It is resolved that owing to dearth of faculties in the department, Dr. Santi Sarkar, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, Centre for Distance and Online Education will teach the students of M.A. 2nd and 4th Semester as guest faculty as per the norms and conditions of Vidyasagar University having a remuneration of Rs 250/per class. Dr. Santi Sarkar will take total 18 classes for 2nd semester to teach PLS 201 (Group-B) (International Relations: Theory and Issues) and 18 classes for 4th semester to teach PLS 401 (Group B) (Major Political Thinkers: Textual Readings). It is further resolved that the Teacher-in-Charge, Dr. Suratha Kumar Malik will write a letter to the Registrar, through the Secretary, Faculty Councils for PG Studies along with the DC resolution requesting him to issue an appointment letter to Dr. Santi Sarkar as Guest Faculty to teach the above papers.

2) All the course papers of M.A. 2nd semester and 4th semester were distributed among the faculties of the department including Dr Santi Sarkar as guest faculty.

- 3) It is resolved that Dr. Sujay Ghosh and Dr. Eyasin Khan will prepare the time table for the upcoming M.A. 2nd and 4th semester in consultation with other faculties.
- 4) It is also resolved that, Dr. Sujay Ghosh (editor of the Department journal) will take initiative regarding preparation of thematic areas, call for papers in different platforms and template of the journal, so that the Department may bring the first revival special issue of the Journal relating to 75th Years of India's independence within end of August 2022.
