Resolutions of the Departmental Committee held on 12.6.2024

1. The minutes of the last meeting held on 12.6.2024 were read and confirmed.
2. The proposal of ICAI to enter into MOU was placed before the members and discussed. It was resolved to invite the proposer along with other representatives of ICAI for a meeting either in offline or online mode for further discussion / clarification on the proposed MoU sent by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. The members also agreed that with respect to the eligibility of Chartered Accountants for Ph.D. Programme in Commerce, the basic educational qualification has to be B.Com. or B.A. / B.Sc. (Economics) along with 55% marks (as per UGC Guidelines) in the qualifying exam.
3. The members resolved to organise outreach programme in the nearby villages areas (preferably those under NSS) for which assistance can be sought from the Vidyasagar University Branch of UCO Bank. Also, the department will seek the financial support of Rs. 10,000 from the university.
4. The members resolved to make effort to enter into academic collaboration with Curtin University, Australia and University of Jaffna, Sri Lanka.
5. Under miscellaneous, the following two issues were discussed
 - a. The proposal of ACE Equity for renewal was placed before the members. It was agreed to renew the database but with no escalation in the price of the product.
 - b. The members discussed the matters relating to installation of ACs in the Commerce Gallery of the Silver Jubilee Building and replacement of the AC in the chamber of the HOD. The members resolved to send a prayer to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor on the same.
